I want to tell you about a couple goals I have as I look towards the new year. I want to work to continue connecting our churches to the resources they need to build a church where all are welcome. I want to involve you more in this work, since I can't do this alone. I want to build up an organization that can be present at every regional assembly and major meeting of Disciples. And I want to build up a trained group of volunteers who can mentor welcome in congregations on the journey towards becoming Open & Affirming.
