By engaging the spiritual practices from the devotional journal <u>Colors of Hope</u>, retreat participants will be encouraged and equipped to embody their faith—and queer their spirituality. With an emphasis on connection over content, all are invited to join the book's editor and authors to wonder, resist, embody, create, hope, stretch, and share.

Christmount is the only formal Open & Affirming outdoor ministry with AllianceQ. The Alliance supports lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and gender-diverse people of faith, educates and equips faith communities for understanding, affirming, and including LGBTQ+ persons, and collaborates with ecumenical partners for intersectional justice work.
