- A father expresses his gratitude for the Open & Affirming Ministry Program, "You're working to build a church where my daughter will be welcome."
- A mother from a Disciples congregation contacts GLAD's Open & Affirming Ministry Program **desperate to find congregations in rural areas** where her friends can attend with their LGBT children. Too often, there isn't one.
- A father talks of the Open & Affirming Disciples congregation and **the life-saving welcome he found for his 10 year old transgender son**.
- A young Disciples pastor tells his story of coming out to his congregation while in seminary, a story that included receiving from his pastor an envelope full of pictures of him at the church, torn to shreds, **and the statement that he is no longer welcome.**

The world needs Open & Affirming churches. Behind every story of affirmation and acceptance is a story of pain and rejection. For every 'it gets better' story there is a story of how bad it is.

And many of these stories don't get better. *Rolling Stone* magazine recently reported on **the rising number of homeless gay teens who are cast out of their homes by religious families**. The statistics on young LGBT people, lacking the support of family and church, who get caught in substance abuse, homelessness, and suicide remain frightening. Without family support, LGB youth are 8.4 times **more likely to report having attempted suicide**, 5.9 times more likely to report high levels of depression, 3.4 times more likely to use illegal drugs.

The Alliance works with you to build a just and inclusive Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) that welcomes persons of all gender expressions and sexual identities into the full life and leadership of the church. **Join us in this work.** Let us end the stories of rejection and increase the stories of love, acceptance and affirmation in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

GLAD has been working diligently. We hired Rev. Dr. Mark Johnston as Executive Director of GLAD's Open & Affirming Ministry Program in July 2013, and since then **24 ministries have been added**. Dr. Johnston is working with pastors and members in our churches, connecting with members at regional assemblies and convocations, **to** show our congregations how to become Open & Affirming in a deeply faithful and grace filled way.

Yet the need is still great. The 122 Open & Affirming congregations in the Christian Church is a mere 3.5% of our churches. We have challenged the Open & Affirming Ministry Program to bring that number up to 5% by the 2015 General Assembly in Columbus, and to 20% by the 2017 General Assembly in Indianapolis.

Join with us as we work together to meet this need. **This ministry is funded by our members, not by the General Church, and we need your support.** Turn this page over, join the GLAD Alliance, and work with us to build a just and inclusive Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) that welcomes persons of all gender expressions and sexual identities into the full life and leadership of the church.
